We can find this idea of emancipation in the three documents.

↳ First of all, we can notice that document A and C reinforce each others. In fact, we can observe that the girls/women represented on it smile, laugh and look away (which is a symbol of ambition, desire...). As the subtitle of the movie poster implies it ("Own your story"), we can see that women are free, independant and maybe proud of themselves. They become who they aspired to be by fighting against men's oppression and typing their opinion, rebelling against codes and promoting their rights. Furthermore, the document C pursues this idea of feeling proud. Indeed, we can notice that the young girl doesn't look anxious or stressed at all, she is proud of herself and doesn't have the pang of remorse.

↳ Finally, the document B enlightens this idea of overcoming a difficulty and being fulfilled thanks to the character of Helen Burns. This latter acts as a spiritual and philosophical mentor to Jane Eyre and helps her in this passage by smiling and looking at her. In fact as we can see with the following sentences "What an extraordinary sensation that ray sent through me! How the new feeling bore me up!" (122-23) that Jane feels more confident and brave thanks to her, in order to
